All you need to know to make this scarf is how to chain and work single crochet stitches!

A great scarf for a beginner crocheter.

Skill: beginner

Sizes: one size

Yarn A: 1 ball
Karabella [Merino Superwash](#) color 13274

Yarn B: 1 skein
Blue Sky Alpacas [Melange](#) color 813

Crochet hook:
size I (5.50mm)

Gauge: 4.5 sts
per inch working
sc stitches

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
beg = beginning



INSTRUCTIONS

Make one

With crochet hook size I (5.50mm) and **Yarn A**
-ch 8, work 8 sc in 2nd ch from hook, join to first sc (not first ch) with sl st to form circle
-repeat above until you run out of yarn!

Finishing

-sew beg of work to the end of your work to form a giant loop

Make one

With crochet hook size I (5.50mm) and two strands of **Yarn B**

Step 1: ch 8, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each to end

Step 2: ch 16, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each of next 7 ch's

-repeat Step 2 until you run out of yarn!

Finishing

-sew beg of work to the end of your work to form a giant loop

FORM THE SCARF

-Fold each long loop in half as shown.

-Then fold the longer one (yarn A) in half again.

-Wrap both pieces around your neck and secure with a shawl pin or make a small chain with remaining yarn to tie together.
