



MIDNIGHT KNITTER

CROCHET DANGLE SCARF

MATERIALS

1 skein Blue Sky Alpacas Alpaca & Silk
1 cone SouthWest Trading Co. Shimmer

crochet hook: US G & D

abbreviations:

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
tr = treble crochet
beg = beginning
st = stitch

INSTRUCTIONS

MAKE NECK:

- With crochet hook G and one strand of each yarn held together, ch 13, work 1 dc in 9th chain from beg, 1 dc in each ch across, ch 3, turn
- Work 1 dc through backloop of each st across, 1 dc in turning ch, ch 3, turn
- (10 dc total including turning ch)
- Repeat above row 21 times (or long enough to fit around your neck)
- At the end of last row, ch 7, join to other end to form loop

MAKE 2 DANGLES:

- With crochet hook G and one strand of each yarn held together, ch 36
- Row 1: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each ch across
- Make oval shape: at the end, ch 7, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 hdc in same, 1 dc in next, 1 dc in next, 1 tr in next, 1 hdc in next, join to end of row 1
- Sc around the oval shape: ch 1, turn, skip 1, 1 sc in each along edge, 2 sc in end st, 1 sc in each ch along next edge (ending at the end of row 1)

MAKE 2 SMALLER DANGLES:

- With crochet hook D and Alpaca Silk, ch 43
- Make oval shape: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 hdc in same, 1 dc in next, 1 dc in next, 1 tr in next, 1 hdc in next, 1 sc in next
- Sc around edges: ch 1, turn, skip 1, 1 sc in each along edge, 1 sc & 1 dc in end st, 1 sc in each ch along next edge.
- Now work 1 sc in each ch along to the beginning (the long chain)

MAKE 2 TASSELS:

- With Shimmer, chain as many sts as you want for the length, end
- Take 4 strands 6 inches long, secure to end of ch to make tassel

FINISHING:

- Secure the "dangles" and tassels to the end of the neck piece, opposite side of the loop (one dangle or tassel to each stitch)
- To wear, pull the dangles through the loop
