



## MIDNIGHT KNITTER

### MONEY PURSE TWO

Make this money purse (wrist wallet, credit card holder, etc.) by crocheting in a spiral. If you haven't worked in a spiral before, it might take you a little bit to get used to. Sometimes when you are turning a corner you will need to add a stitch or make one less, depending on how tightly you crochet. Just be sure to adjust your work as you go around so that the crochet piece lays flat.

#### Size

To fit credit cards and money of course.  
4.5" x 4.5"

#### Materials

1 ball Noro Silk Garden  
crochet hook size G (4mm)  
one zipper, 4.5" long or velcro dots

#### Gauge

4.5 sts = 1"

#### Abbreviations:

ch - chain

st(s) - stitch(es)

in next - in next stitch

sl st - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

beg - beginning





## INSTRUCTIONS - MAKE TWO

- ch 4, join with sl st to form ring, ch 1
- work 7 sc in center of ring, do not turn, start working spiral

**NOTE:** the following are not rounds, just spaced apart so the pattern can be followed easily. This is crocheted in a spiral.

- 2 sc in next 5 sts, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next
- \*1 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next; repeat from \* once more, \*1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next; repeat from \* once more, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next
- \*1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next; repeat from \* once more, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next
- \*1 sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next; repeat from \* two more times
- \*1 sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next; repeat from \* five more times
- \*1 sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next; repeat from \* four more times
- 1 sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 2 hdc in next
- 1 sc in next 6 sts, in next work 1 sc and 1 hdc, 1 hdc in next 3 sts
- 1 sc in next 7 sts, in next work 1 sc and 1 hdc, in next work 1 sc and 1 hdc
- 1 sc in next 9 sts, in next work 1 sc and 1 hdc
- 1 sc in next 10 sts, in next work 1 sc and 1 hdc
- 1 sc in next 12 sts, 2 sc in next
- 1 sc in next 9 sts, in next work 1 hdc and 1 dc, 2 dc in next, 1 hdc in next
- 1 sc in next 9 sts, in next work 1 sc and 1 hdc
- in next work 1 hdc and 1 dc, 1 dc in next, 1 hdc in next, 1 sc in next
- slip st to next st, cut yarn

## TO MAKE HANDLE

- ch 40, work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each ch across
- ch 1, turn, 1 sc in each across, end
- fold in half and sew to corner of purse

## TO JOIN PIECES AND SEW ZIPPER OR VELCRO

- place front and back with wrong sides together, sl st along the edge to join, leaving about 1 inch unstitched at the edges of the opening (for room to sew zipper, SEE PHOTO BELOW)
- fold top edges down a bit to pin zipper into place, sew zipper to inside of purse (alternately, you can use a button and a crochet chain for closure, or sew Velcro dots to the inside)
