



Crochet Keychain

A fun little crochet project that can be made during only one episode of Friends! haha.

approx size:
2.5" x 2.5"



free pattern

crochet hook: E

yarn: Debbie Bliss Wool Cotton

OR any stiff yarn of the gauge:
6.25 sts per inch on US 4 needles

MC: red
CC: light grey

Abbreviations:

ch (chain)
sc (single crochet)
hdc (half double crochet)
dc (double crochet)
sl st (slip stitch)
* to * (repeat between stars)

FRONT

crochet in a spiral

- with MC, ch 5, join with sl st to form ring (do not chain 1)
- work 8 sc in center of ring, do not turn, start working spiral
- 2 sc in each around (16 sc)

the following are not rounds, just spaced apart so the pattern can be followed easy

- work *1 sc, 2 sc in next* 9 times
- switch to CC
- work *1 sc, 1 sc, 2 sc in next* twice
- work 1 hdc, 1 hdc and 1 dc in next, 1 dc, 2 dc in next, 1 dc, 2 hdc in next, 1 hdc, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 3
- switch to MC
- 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 3, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 4, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in each of next 5, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 15, sl st to next, END

BACK

-work the same as front, but switch MC and CC to make a mirror of the front

SEW FRONT AND BACK TOGETHER

- place front and back wrong sides together, using sl st crochet through one loop of each side, secure around. leave a small opening to add stuffing or extra yarn, then secure the rest of the way.
- add a little chain stitch loop to attach to a keyring



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
