Karaoke Cable Scarf

This self striping yarn is perfect for cool scarves! The simple cable pattern makes it interesting and fun to knit.

yarn:

2 balls SWTC Karaoke color 280

Or 220 yards of any worsted weight yarn

crochet hook: US 7

INSTRUCTIONS

With yarn and US 7 needles, cast on 22 stitches.

Row 1: k2, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k2

Row 2: k4, p6, k2, p6, k4

Repeat above rows two more times for a total of 6 rows.

Start cable rows:

Row 7: k2, p2, C6F, p2, C6B, p2, k2

Row 8: k4, p6, k2, p6, k4

Row 9: k2, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k2

Row 10: k4, p6, k2, p6, k4

Row 11: k2, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k2

Row 12: k4, p6, k2, p6, k4

Row 13: k2, p2, k6, p2, k6, p2, k2

Row 14: k4, p6, k2, p6, k4

Repeat above cable rows section until your scarf measures 60" long, bind off.

Use remaining yarn to make tassels!

Abbreviations:

k = knit

p = purl

C6F: slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, knit next 3 sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

C6B: slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, knit next 3 sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from cable needle.

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
