

### Materials:

MC: 1 skein Blue Sky Alpacas, Alpaca Silk, black  
CC: 1 skein Blue Sky Alpacas, Alpaca Silk, white

crochet hook: size I (5.5mm)

**Gauge:** 5.5 sts per inch

**Size:** 2.75" x 80"

### Abbreviations:

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
dc = double crochet  
st(s) = stitch(es)

### Instructions:

With MC, chain 17

Row 1: Work 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each across, turn (15 sc)

**NOTE:** Count the turning chain as the first stitch of the row

Row 2: Ch 3, 1 dc in each across, turn. (15 dc)

Row 3: Ch 3, 1 dc in each across and in turning chain, turn. (15 dc)

Repeat **Row 3** throughout the scarf, changing colors as follows:

8 rows MC

4 rows CC

7 rows MC

16 rows CC

21 rows MC

21 rows CC

2 rows MC

10 rows CC

5 rows MC

7 rows CC

6 rows MC

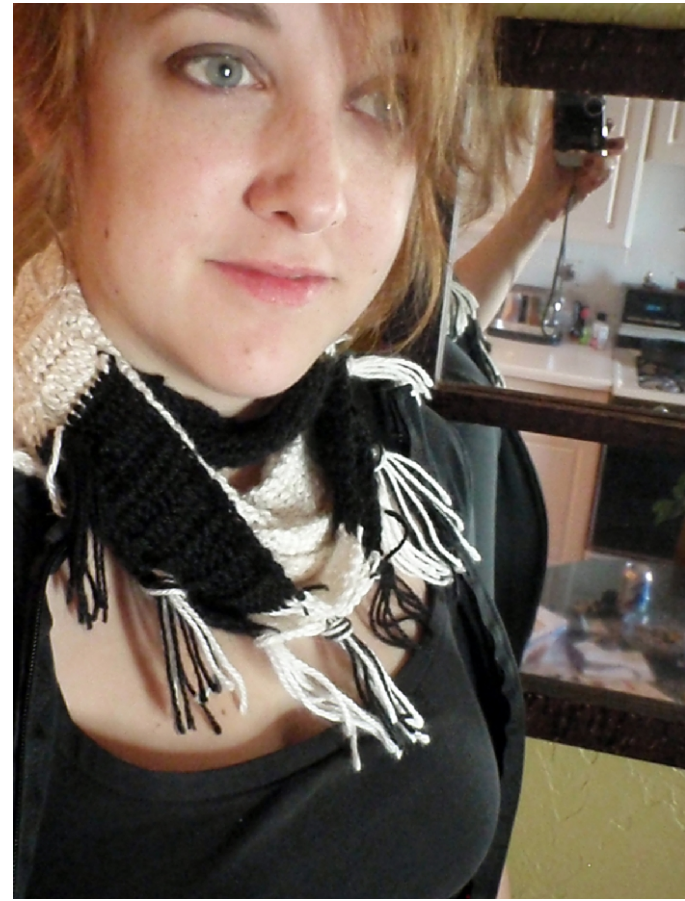
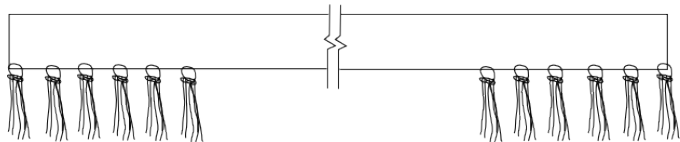
6 rows CC

7 rows MC

Cut yarn and weave ends.

Take remaining yarn and cut 8" lengths.

Group 6 strands together and secure tassels along the edge of the scarf as shown below. I made 6 tassels on each side.
