

PUNK CROCHET WRIST WARMERS V.2

Easy to crochet wrist warmers. The bobbles on the top of the glove can be left out if desired by using a single crochet instead of a treble crochet in those sections of the pattern.

The addition of the thumb section makes them warmer than a knitted tube style wristlette. The only stitch you need to know is single crochet!

A great project for a beginner.

Sizes

Fits average Womens hand.

The yarn is stretchy, well suited to one-size-fits-all.

Materials

2 balls Karabella Merino Superwash

MC = color 12482 CC = color 12940

Crochet hook size G (4.0mm)

Gauge

4.5 sts and 4 rows on 4.0mm hook, single crochet

Abbreviations:

st(s) - stitch(es)

ch- chain

slst - slip stitch

sc - single crochet

tr - treble crochet

tbl: through back loop only





INSTRUCTIONS

RIGHT MITTENETTE

Start by making cuff

(all sts are worked **thru back loop** only for the cuff)

-With MC, ch 16, 1 sc in 3rd ch from hook, 1 sc in each of next 13, turn

Row 1: ch 1, 1 sc tbl in each of next 13 sc, 1 sc in end, turn (15 sts) **Rows 2 to 29:** same as row 4

Fold rectangle in half lengthwise to join beg ch row with last row worked using slst to corresponding sts, finishing the cuff.

Note: From here on, all ch 1 sts are NOT COUNTED as sts. To make a tight seam at the joining of rounds you will be skipping the ch 1 and joining to the first sc of the round.

-Turn cuff inside out, you will now be working into the ENDS of the cuff rows to make mitten.

Round 1: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in end of each row around, join with slst to first sc, turn (29 sc)

Switch to CC

For round 2 you will be inserting the hook from the inside of the mitten to the outside, so if your work is facing the wrong way, turn the mitten inside out again

Round 2: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sts)

Round 3: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sts)

Round 4: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 8, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each of next 3, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each of next 3, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sts) you now have bobbles on the outside of your mittenette.

Round 5: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sts)

Round 6: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 19, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (31 sts)

Round 7: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 13, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 8, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (34 sts)

Round 8: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 12, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each of next 4, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (34 sts)

Round 9: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (34 sts)

Round 10: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in next, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (36 sts)

Round 11: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (36 sts)

Round 12: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 17, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn

Round 13: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 27, join with sc loosely to first sc (leaving thumb section unworked), turn

Round 14: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, before joining to first sc, work one more sc in the loose loop from the join in the previous round, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sc)

Round 15: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sc)



Rounds 16 to 18: same as round 15

Cut yarn and weave tail

MAKE THUMB

Join MC to thumb sts at join of hand and thumb, ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each around and 2 sc in loose loop between hand and thumb (12 sts), do not turn or join

Work 1 sc in each around, in a spiral (no turning) for 3-1/2 rounds, ending at the outside of thumb, cut yarn and weave tail

LEFT MITTENETTE

Work cuff as for RIGHT.

Then work mitten as for RIGHT to round 3.

Round 4: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 11, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each of next 3, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each of next 3, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sts) you now have bobbles on the outside of your mittenette.

Round 5: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sts)

Round 6: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 19, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (31 sts)

Round 7: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 13, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 8, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (34 sts)

Round 8: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 16, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each of next 4, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (34 sts)

Round 9: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (34 sts)

Round 10: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 29, 2 sc in next, 1 sc in each of next 2, 2 sc in next, join to first sc with slst, turn (36 sts)

Round 11: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (36 sts)

Round 12: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each of next 19, 1 tr in next, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn

Round 13: ch 1, join with sc loosely to 9th sc of previous round, 1 sc in each to end, 1 sc in beg ch 1, join to first loose sc (leaving thumb section unworked), turn

Round 14: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, 1 sc in loose sc from prev round, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sc)

Round 15: ch 1, 1 sc in same, 1 sc in each to end, join to first sc with slst, turn (29 sc)

Rounds 16 to 18: same as round 15

- -Cut yarn and weave tail.
- -Work thumb as for Right Mittenette.
