



MIDNIGHT KNITTER

SPILO CAP

A standard knit cap using Plymouth Yarns Adriafile Spillo. It knits up as a bulky weight yarn, but it is very light and airy. When substituting yarn for this discontinued yarn, choose a very fluffy and stretchy chunky or bulky weight that can knit to the gauge listed below.

difficulty: advanced beginner

size: womens 20" to 23" head

MATERIALS

1 ball Plymouth Yarns Adriafile Spillo

needles: US 10 circular 16" long
(or size to obtain gauge)

and US 9 dpns

gauge: 4.5 sts = 1"

knits up a bit loose at this gauge, which is the desired result

abbreviations:

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

k4, p2 rib = k4, p2 around

[] = repeat between brackets

skp = slip 1 knitwise, k1, pass

slipped stitch over

k2tog = k 2 sts together

INSTRUCTIONS

- with US 10 circular, cast on 66 sts, join in the round, place
- marker to mark beginning of round
- work k4, p2 rib for 6 rows
- k all sts for 3 rows
- START STITCH PATTERN
- next row: k4, p1, [k5, p1] around, end with k1
- next row: k4, p1, [k5, p1] around, end with k1
- k all sts for 4 rows
- repeat from START STITCH PATTERN two more times
- next row: k4, p1, [k5, p1] around, end with k1
- start decreasing for top of hat
- next row: [k9, skp] around
- next row: k all sts
- next row: [k8, k2tog] around
- next row: k all sts
- next row: [k7, skp] around
- next row: k all sts
- next row: [k6, k2tog] around
- next row: k all sts
- switch to US 9 double pointed needles,
- knit remainder of hat loosely
- next row: [k5, skp] around
- next row: [k4, k2tog] around
- next row: [k2tog] around
- cut yarn and pull thru remaining sts to close.
